Ongoing Mentorship	Meet with a student, on a monthly basis, regarding professionalism and skills needed to excel in today's workforce.
Speak to a classroom	Attract youth to your business and industry and provide community outreach. Engage with our future workforce.
Externship for Teachers	Host a teacher to spend a week at your business to learn about industry trends, resulting in further preparing our youth and future workforce.
