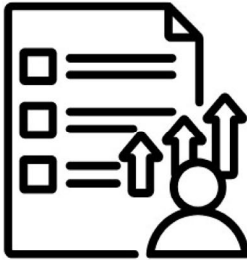
RMCEP Career Advising Program: Supporting Schools & Workforce Readiness

Personal Learning Plans

Personal Learning Plans (PLPs) are customized educational strategies developed through individual student sessions and tools like the Minnesota Career Information System (MCIS).

Lessons, Approaches and Testing

Instruction on topics emphasizing academic rigor, including study skills, the changing workforce, course selection for college and career readiness, in-demand occupations, and SMART goals. Proctor the National Career Readiness Certificate and assist with military or college admissions.

Education/Training and Career Options

Offer assistance and instruction on career exploration, occupations in demand, education training options, and career pathways (military, workforce, college certificate/ diploma/degree, apprenticeship, and internship)
