PRIMARY INDUSTRY SECTORS:

Healthcare

Nursing, CNA, Dental Tech, Medical Tech, Medical Coding, Phlebotomy, etc.

Manufacturing

Architectural Drafting, Construction Management, Welding and Soldering, etc.

Education

Adult/Vocational Education, Paraprofessionals, K-12 Teaching, etc.

Agriculture

Transportation

PARTICIPANTS ENROLLED **MUST BE AUTHORIZED TO WORK IN THE UNITED STATES AND MUST BE PART OF ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:**

- Individuals that Identify as BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People Of Color)
- Individuals lacking Stable Housing
- Individuals who are Justice Involved
- Individuals who lack a High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Individuals with Disabilities
- Individuals who have been Unemployed for 26 or More of the Past 52 Weeks
- Workers currently employed in applicant LWDA sectors, earning less than a living wage, based on respective family size
- Individuals with English as a Second Language
- Individuals at or Below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guideline
- Individuals with Professional Degree and Licensure issued outside the United States who seek to re-enter the skills workforce and earn professional license(s) to do similar work
